

# Firmware Update for NEXT Camera

## General Description

Vicon has released firmware for the NEXT evaluation units.

Cameras online and connected to Anavio will receive the update automatically. Any offline cameras or cameras connected to third-party platforms should update via the camera interface.

## Key Updates

### Enhanced Imaging with High Dynamic Range (HDR)

For scenes that contain both very bright and very dark areas, HDR is now available to deliver more balanced and detailed images.

- HDR can be enabled via the Web UI, ONVIF, or Anavio camera settings.
- HDR automatically turns off when AI Denoise is enabled and turns back on when AI Denoise is disabled.

### System Stability & Performance Improvements

- Fixed an issue where firmware updates could occasionally cause the Network Hub to become unresponsive. Updates are now smoother and more dependable.

## Known Issues

### HDR Transition Delay

During day-to-night or night-to-day transitions, the camera may take several minutes to adjust, with occasional image flickering during the switch.

### Video Analytics Event Disruption

Video analytics events may stop triggering after extended use when HDR is enabled.


### Sensor Reboots in Anavio

The sensor may reboot frequently in Anavio when Face Detection and HDR are both enabled.

# How to update your firmware

If your camera is connected to Anavio, it will automatically receive an over-the-air update. No action required for the user.

1. Log into your camera firmware
2. Navigate to Settings > Maintenance > System



3. Under "Firmware Update" select "Choose file." Upload the .bin file.
